



## Detailed Room Descriptions

All of the public rooms at the castle are on the first floor. There are bedrooms on the ground, first and second floors, all of which are accessible by lift, though some are more suitable than others for guests who have difficulty with stairs. The castle has good facilities and access for the disabled. Please ask at the time of reservation if you require these facilities.

There are seventeen guest rooms at Glenapp. All are individually decorated and furnished and equipped to the same high standard. They are priced according to their location in the building, their views and their floor area. Our smallest room is 198 square feet - by no means small but our largest rooms are 630 square feet and this is reflected in the room rates.

Many of our rooms have superb sea views. The rooms with lesser views of our gardens and woodland are lower priced. Our ground floor rooms are lower priced than our first and second floor rooms. The rooms are described in detail and pictured below, grouped from 1 - 6 in order of price, from highest to lowest.

## 'Earl of Inchcape' (Price Group 1)



'The Earl of Inchcape', which measures 630 square feet, is a second floor Master Room and was originally the bedroom of the Earls of Inchcape who owned Glenapp up until 1982. The room has a high ceiling with ornate plasterwork cornicing and frieze as well as a magnificent crystal chandelier and the tall sash windows boast panoramic views out over finely kept gardens to the Irish Sea and the massive granite rock called Ailsa Craig. Beyond lies the island of Arran and the Mull of Kintyre.

The bedroom is luxuriously furnished decorated in a Cole and Sons wallpaper with antiques including an enormous marquetry inlaid mahogany wardrobe and an ebonised mahogany credenza housing a display of porcelain china. A mahogany dining table and chairs allow for romantic private dining if required. Above the antique French carved fireplace with real flame gas fire hangs a magnificent portrait of an unknown Spanish Beauty and a large comfortable sofa and two armchairs with feather cushions are placed around the fire.

The dressing table is a large mahogany sofa table with an elegant antique mirror. The bed is the original six foot square four poster with its own crystal chandelier. It is opulently draped in 'Piquet', a striking red and black fabric by Nina Campbell to match the seating. A chaise longue at its foot is covered in the same fabric. There are two large vibrantly coloured 'Shah Abbas' rugs over warm barley coloured fitted Wilton carpet.

The room has two turrets one being a tiny circular room and the other giving access to a private oak spiral staircase, which leads to a private doorway to the gardens. This room, as with all rooms at Glenapp has a large television, DVD, VCR a CD player and direct dial telephone.

The en suite bathroom is large, approximately 100 square feet and houses a large cast iron Victorian style 'claw-foot' bathtub as well as a separate walk in shower compartment and a large pedestal basin. All bathrooms have a heated towel rail luxury towels and bathrobes and toiletries by Penhaligon. They also have a telephone extension. The walls are traditionally panelled in cream painted wood panelling to a height of eight feet and a mahogany washstand sits below the large window.

## 'The Earl of Orkney' (Price Group 1)



The second of our Master Rooms is situated on the first floor of the castle next door to the library and is named for a previous owner of the property who did much to develop the gardens and landscape the surrounding woodlands.

The room is very large, approximately 630 square feet. It has a high ceiling with ornate plasterwork and two large crystal chandeliers. The walls are in a pale yellow damask paper by Cole and Son and rich blue and gold curtain fabric is 'Marivaux' from the Design Archives.

The fitted Wilton carpet is a warm barley colour with two large vibrantly coloured 'Shah Abbas' rugs. A large and comfortable sofa and armchairs with feather cushions surround an Adam style fireplace with real flame gas fire. Above the fireplace with its antique marble mantel clock hangs an original oil painting of a coastal scene.

The tall sash windows give panoramic views over immaculate gardens out across the Irish Sea to the massive granite rock of Ailsa Craig and on to the Island of Arran and the Mull of Kintyre.

An antique mahogany parlour suite sits in one of the triple windows and in the other, a large sofa table with antique dressing table mirror and a mahogany cheval mirror. Other antique pieces in the room include a Regency mahogany writing bureau and a Georgian chest of drawers as well as a walnut dining table and chairs for romantic private dining if required. There is a large walk-in wardrobe and the bed is a six foot six inch wide half tester which is convertible to twin beds if required. There are two turrets, one of which houses a tiny circular room and the other an oak spiral stair, which provides a private exit to the gardens.

The room has a large television and DVD, VCR, a CD player and direct dial telephone.

The en suite bathroom is large, approximately 56 square feet and has a large cast iron bathtub with an over bath shower as well as a large pedestal washbasin and a heated towel rail. Towels and bathrobes are luxurious, as are the Penhaligon toiletries. All bathrooms have a telephone extension.

## 'Arran Suite' (Price Group 1)



This second floor luxury double or twin room measures 278 square feet and is decorated in a beautiful 'Zoffany' wallpaper called 'Gothic Flower'. The barley coloured fitted carpets are Wilton and there is a large colourful 'Shah Abbas' over rug.

Furnishings include an antique mahogany secretaire desk and a large inlaid mahogany wardrobe as well as an attractive antique mahogany washstand and three comfortable armchairs. There is also an antique mahogany dressing table and side table. The half tester bed is six feet six inches wide and can be converted to twin beds if required.

This room has spectacular views out across the castle gardens and the Irish Sea to the massive granite rock of Ailsa Craig, the island of Arran and the Mull of Kintyre.

There is a television, DVD, VCR, CD player and trouser press in the bedroom as well as direct dial telephone.

The Bedroom has a connecting door to a large, 300 square foot private sitting room, with an Adam style fireplace with real flame gas fire and two large windows with views across the gardens and out to sea. There is an oak dining table in the room. There is an additional television in the sitting room.

The 'Arran Suite' can be made available as a one or two bedroom suite along with 'Ailsa Craig' an en-suite Luxury Double Room, if required.

The 'Arran Suite' bathroom, which retains its original marble wall panelling and flooring, measures 80 square feet. There is a large Victorian style clawfoot bathtub with shower attachment as well as a separate walk in shower compartment. The bathroom also has a pedestal washbasin and a heated towel rail with luxury towels and bathrobes. The toiletries are by Penhaligon and all bathrooms have direct dial telephone.

## 'Ballantrae Suite' (Price Group 2)



Our family suite consists of two ground floor guest rooms, Kilantringan and Ballantrae, which can be reserved separately, but can also interconnect giving a two bedroom suite with two bathrooms. Ballantrae can be double or twin bedded and Kilantringan has a five foot queen size double bed making the suite ideal for parents with two children. There is plenty of space for a third roll away bed or a cot for families with three children. The suite is also popular for three adult guests.

Ballantrae measures 306 square feet. There are two large windows overlooking the gardens and the sea to the rear of the castle. There is a built in wardrobe and the fitted carpets are barley coloured Wilton, with a large and colourful 'Shah Abbas' over rug.

There is an antique mahogany 'Kilt' dressing table (designed to allow a gentleman to adjust the length of his kilt!) as well as an antique mahogany chest of drawers, over which hangs an original Victorian oil painting of the little village of Ballantrae which can be seen down by the Irish Sea below the castle. There is an antique mahogany writing desk and two comfortable armchairs as well as a chaise longue at the foot of the canopied bed.

The bed is six feet six inches wide and can be converted to twin beds if required.

There is a television, DVD, VCR and CD player and trouser press as well as direct dial telephone

The bathroom measures 42 square feet and has a large cast iron bath tub with over bath shower and pedestal basin as well a heated towel rail with luxury towels and bathrobes. Toiletries are by Penhaligon and there is a direct dial telephone.

Kilantringan measures 242 square feet and has lovely views over the croquet lawn. The walls are decorated in a deep yellow Osbourne and Little wallpaper and there is a fine Edwardian Oak bedroom suite consisting of dressing table, large wardrobe and bed head. The double bed measures five feet by six feet three inches. There are two comfortable armchairs and an antique day couch, as well as an antique mahogany writing table with a Victorian oil painting showing a rural scene hung above. The fitted carpets are barley coloured Wilton and there is a colourful 'Shah Abbas' over rug. There is a television, DVD, VCR and CD player and trouser press as well as direct dial telephone.

The bathroom measures 54 square feet and houses a large, cast iron bathtub with over bath shower and a pedestal wash basin. There is a heated towel rail with luxury towels and bathrobes. Toiletries are by Penhaligon and there is a direct dial telephone.

## 'Bryce' (Price Group 3)



This suite, is named for David Bryce, the eminent Victorian architect who designed Glenapp Castle for it's first owner in the 1870's. Bryce was famous for his 'Scottish Baronial' style and was responsible for many of the great Victorian Castles built for the eminent landowners of the day. The suite is decorated in a vibrant red colour scheme with paper by Nina Campbell. There are fitted barley coloured Wilton carpets and colourful 'Shah Abbas' over rugs.

In the bedroom area there is an original white marble fireplace with real flame gas fire and a huge over mantel mirror. Two intricately carved inlaid mahogany parlour chairs sit by the fire and a large sofa table with antique dressing table mirror sits in the triple window overlooking the immaculate gardens. There are three large fitted wardrobes and the bed is a large six foot six inch wide double which can be converted to twin beds if required.

There is an antique mahogany chest of drawers and there are two original oil paintings in the bedroom, one of a coastal scene and the other showing a river view. There is a television, DVD, VCR and CD player and direct dial telephone.

The small sitting room is decorated with complementary wallpaper and the same dark red damask fabric is used in the curtains. There is an additional television set with VCR and a large and comfortable two seater sofa which can convert into a child's bed if required. A large oil painting by Douglas Cameron showing a Highland scene hangs over a demi-lune mahogany side table and there is an additional antique mahogany chest of drawers.

The 60 square foot en suite bathroom still has its original marble floor and the walls are panelled in the same marble to a height of five feet. There is a large original cast iron bathtub with over bath shower and a pedestal wash basin as well as a heated towel rail with luxury towels and bathrobes and toiletries by Penhaligon. All bathrooms have a telephone extension.

## 'Hunter' (Price Group 3)



This first floor suite with courtyard and woodland views is named for James Hunter Esq, the Deputy Lord Lieutenant of Ayrshire who was responsible for commissioning the building of Glenapp Castle. Hunter was a wealthy merchant and owned the castle until the early part of the last century. The suite is decorated in a rich blue green colour scheme with wallpaper by Nina Campbell.

The bedroom area is large, approximately 240 square feet. There are fitted barley coloured Wilton carpets and colourful 'Shah Abbas' over rugs. There is a mahogany fireplace with a cast iron insert in which burns a real flame gas fire. Over the fireplace is a large original oil painting of a highland scene by the Victorian artist Douglas Cameron.

A large triple door inverted breakfront mahogany wardrobe rests in an alcove while in the triple windows, sits a large sofa table with dressing table mirror. The suite has views over the castle forecourt and gardens. There is also an antique mahogany chest of drawers.

The bed is a canopied six foot six inch wide double which can be converted to twin beds if required.

There is a television, DVD, VCR and CD player in the bedroom area as well as direct dial telephone.

The separate sitting room measures 130 square feet and is decorated in complementary wallpaper and fabrics. There is a cast iron fireplace with real flame gas fire over which hangs a large original oil portrait. An antique mahogany side table and occasional table and a large antique mahogany chest of drawers are also present along with a television, VCR, CD player and direct dial telephone. A comfortable two seater sofa and a parlour chair provide the seating.

The sofa can convert into a four foot, six inch wide double bed if required.

The bathroom has its original marble flooring and cream painted wood panelled walls to a height of four feet. It measures 56 square feet. There is a large Edwardian cast iron bath tub with over bath shower, a pedestal wash basin and a heated towel rail along with luxurious towels and bathrobes and high quality toiletries by Penhaligon. All bathrooms have direct dial telephone.

## 'Ailsa Craig' (Price Group 4)



This second floor luxury double room measures 278 square feet and has beautiful views out over the gardens and the Irish Sea to the massive granite rock of Ailsa Craig, for which it is named. The island of Arran and the Mull of Kintyre are also clearly visible.

The colour scheme is a delicate terracotta and yellow with Florentine Damask wallpaper by Zoffany and the canopied bed is a six foot by six foot three inch king size double. There are fitted barley coloured Wilton carpets and a colourful 'Shah Abbas' over rug. There is an attractive Edwardian mahogany and walnut bedroom suite consisting of a triple wardrobe, dressing table and washstand as well as an antique mahogany side table.

There are two large and comfortable armchairs, a television, DVD, VCR and CD player, trouser press and direct dial telephone. There is a pair of original Victorian watercolours and another original oil painting. This bedroom has connecting doors to a large, 300 square foot private sitting room named 'Elsie Mackay' (after a daughter of the Inchcape family whose light aircraft was lost at sea in the 1930's).

This accommodation can be made available as a one or two bedroom suite along with 'Arran' another of our luxury double/twin bedrooms.

The sitting room has two large windows overlooking the gardens and the sea, an 'Adam' style fireplace with real flame gas fire and a large four seat sofa.

The bathroom measures 90 square feet and still has its original pale beige marble wall panelling. There is an Edwardian cast iron bath tub with an over bath shower, a heated towel rail and pedestal wash basin, luxurious towels and bathrobes and toiletries by Penhaligon. All bathrooms have direct dial telephone.

## 'The Countess of Inchcape' (Price Group 4)



This delightful second floor luxury double or twin room has very ornate plasterwork walls decorated in a pale yellow and cream colour scheme. The room measures 330 square feet and has the benefit of a separate dressing area. The views are panoramic, looking out over the gardens and the Irish Sea to the massive granite rock of Ailsa Craig, the island of Arran and the Mull of Kintyre. There are fitted barley coloured Wilton carpets with colourful 'Shah Abbas' over rugs and pale green and cream toile curtains and fabrics by Titley and Marr.

The bed is a half tester measuring six foot six inches wide. It can be converted to twin beds if required.

There is a magnificent inlaid antique walnut chest on chest, an inlaid antique mahogany wardrobe and an ornately carved walnut 'Duchess' dressing table, which is also an antique. There are original Victorian watercolours on the walls and two comfortable armchairs as well as an antique mahogany writing desk. There is a television, DVD, VCR and CD player and direct dial telephone.

The bathroom is very large, measuring 134 square feet. The walls are cream painted wood panelling with a terracotta frieze to match the ceramic floor tiles. The bathtub is a large Victorian style clawfoot tub with a shower attachment and there is also a separate walk in shower cabinet. The pedestal basin has a large marble shelf and the heated towel rail is home to large luxurious towels and bathrobes. The toiletries are by Penhaligon.

This large bathroom is also home to a beautiful Victorian mahogany shaving mirror and an antique mahogany 'whatnot'.

## 'The Dial Room'

(Price Group 5)



This second floor luxury double or twin room is so called because the large stone sundial above the castle's main entrance is situated directly below the bedroom window, and the room looks out over the front courtyard of the castle to the woodland beyond.

The room measures 264 square feet and is decorated in a deep red wallpaper by Sheila Coombs. There is a very large dark mahogany wardrobe and a large sofa table with antique dressing table mirror. There are two comfortable armchairs and an antique writing bureau, above which hangs a large Victorian oil painting of a Highland pony in saddle painted by David Murray.

The half tester bed is six feet six inches wide and can be converted to twin beds if required. There is a television, DVD, VCR and CD player and trouser press as well as direct dial telephone.

This bedroom has a separate WC situated within a circular tower room, which, according to the present Earl was at one time, where the governess of the Inchcape children kept her canes! The 64 square foot bathroom has an original Edwardian cast iron bathtub with an over bath shower and a pedestal basin as well as a heated towel rail and washstand. All bathrooms have luxurious towels and bathrobes and toiletries by Penhaligon as well as direct dial telephone.

## 'Garleffin' (Price Group 5)



This bright first floor room is in the East Wing of the castle near to the suites and measures 294 square feet. It has views of the sea and the gardens.

The canopied bed is a six foot by six foot three king size double. There is an antique mahogany secretaire and dressing table and wardrobe set. The carved Adam style fireplace has a real flame gas fire and a fine oil painting of two young goat kids by J Murray Thomson hangs above it.

There are two wing chairs and the barley coloured fitted carpets are Wilton with a colourful 'Shah Abbas' over rug. The wallpaper is pale yellow by Colefax and Fowler and the bed canopy and chairs are covered in a rich blue fabric. There is a television, DVD, VCR and CD player and trouser press as well as direct dial telephone.

The bathroom measures 44 square feet and houses a large cast iron bathtub with over bath shower and a pedestal basin. There is a heated towel rail with luxurious towels and bathrobes and the toiletries are by Penhaligon. There is a direct dial telephone.

## 'Knockdolian' (Price Group 5)



This large ground floor bedroom was originally the butler's quarters. It measures 420 square feet and has its own private doorway to the gardens.

The room is decorated in a beautiful 'Flemish Stripe' wallpaper by Zoffany and the deep blue damask curtain fabric is by Andrew Martin. The room has a mahogany fireplace with real flame gas fire around which are grouped a Knole sofa and two large wing chairs. There are excellent views of the gardens from this bedroom, which also boasts a king size antique brass four poster bed.

There is a large antique mahogany wardrobe, dressing table and chest of drawers as well as a large antique fruit wood chest at the foot of the bed. The barley coloured fitted carpets are Wilton and there is a colourful 'Shah Abbas' rug. There is a television, DVD, VCR and CD player and trouser press as well as direct dial telephone.

The bathroom measures 96 square feet and has a Victorian style cast iron claw foot bathtub with shower attachment as well as a separate walk in shower compartment, a pedestal washbasin, and luxurious towels and bathrobes. Toiletries are by Penhaligon and all bathrooms have direct dial telephone.

## 'Ballantrae' (Price Group 5)



This large ground floor room measures 306 square feet. There are two large windows overlooking the gardens and the sea to the rear of the castle. There is a built in wardrobe and the fitted carpets are barley coloured Wilton, with a large and colourful 'Shah Abbas' over rug.

There is an antique mahogany 'Kilt' dressing table (designed to allow a gentleman to adjust the length of his kilt!) as well as an antique mahogany chest of drawers, over which hangs an original Victorian oil painting of the little village of Ballantrae which can be seen down by the Irish Sea below the castle. There is an antique mahogany writing desk and two comfortable armchairs as well as a chaise longue at the foot of the canopied bed. The bed is six feet six inches wide and can be converted to twin beds if required. There is a television, DVD, VCR and CD player and trouser press as well as direct dial telephone

The bathroom measures 42 square feet and has a large cast iron bath tub with over bath shower and pedestal basin as well a heated towel rail with luxury towels and bathrobes. Toiletries are by Penhaligon and there is a direct dial telephone.

## 'Kilantringan' (Price Group 6)



This luxury garden view bedroom measures 242 square feet and has views over the croquet lawn. The walls are decorated in a deep yellow Osbourne and Little wallpaper and there is a fine Edwardian Oak bedroom suite consisting of dressing table, large wardrobe and bed head. The double bed measures five feet by six feet three inches.

There are two comfortable armchairs and an antique day couch, as well as an antique mahogany writing table with a Victorian oil painting showing a rural scene hung above. The fitted carpets are barley coloured Wilton and there is a colourful 'Shah Abbas' over rug. There is a television, DVD, VCR and CD player and trouser press as well as direct dial telephone.

The bathroom measures 54 square feet and houses a large, cast iron bathtub with over bath shower and a pedestal wash basin. There is a heated towel rail with luxury towels and bathrobes. Toiletries are by Penhaligon and there is a direct dial telephone.

## 'Beneraird' (Price Group 6)



This ground floor bedroom with sea and garden views measures 336 square feet. It is decorated in an attractive pale peach wallpaper and has a separate dressing area with fitted wardrobe and antique mahogany dressing table and chest of drawers.

The bed measures six feet six inches wide and can be converted to twin beds if required. There is an original black slate fireplace (not operational) with a marble mantel clock above which hangs an original Edwardian oil painting by Edwin Moore of a coastal scene. A copper bed warming pan hangs on the wall. There is an antique writing bureau and two comfortable armchairs sit by an occasional table in the window overlooking the lawns and gardens at the rear of the castle. There is a television, DVD, VCR and CD player and trouser press as well as direct dial telephone

The bathroom measures 105 square feet and has a large cast iron bathtub with over bath shower. There is a pedestal basin by the window and a heated towel rail with luxury towels and bathrobes. Toiletries are by Penhaligon and all bathrooms have direct dial telephone.

## 'Ardstinchar' (Price Group 6)



This luxury garden view room measures 259 square feet and is named after the ruined castle in the village of Ballantrae, for centuries a stronghold of the Kennedy's of Cassillis. There is a fine Edwardian oak dressing table with a large matching wardrobe. The barley coloured fitted carpets are Wilton and there is a colourful 'Shah Abbas' over rug. The double windows look out over lawns to the tennis court.

The walls are covered in a rich striped yellow paper and fabrics are by Zoffany. There are two comfortable armchairs.

The half tester bed is a standard UK double measuring four feet six inches by six feet three inches. There is a television, DVD, VCR and CD player and trouser press as well as direct dial telephone.

The large bathroom measures 78 square feet and houses a Victorian style cast iron claw foot bathtub with shower attachment as well as a large separate walk in shower compartment and pedestal basin. There is an old-fashioned high level cistern and Victorian style ceramic tiling. There is also a heated towel rail with luxury towels and bathrobes. Toiletries are by Penhaligon and there is a direct dial telephone.

## 'Auchencrosh' (Price Group 6)



This ground floor bedroom measures 291 square feet. The barley coloured fitted carpets are Wilton and there is a colourful 'Shah Abbas' over rug. The bedroom houses an antique walnut dressing table and marble topped washstand as well as an antique mahogany chest of drawers and wardrobe.

There is a two seater sofa and two armchairs and a mahogany bureau. The half tester bed measures six feet six inches wide and can be converted into twin beds if required. The room looks out over the castle forecourt to the woodland beyond.

## 'Viscount Glenapp' (Price Group 6)



The eldest son of an Earl of Inchcape holds the courtesy title of Viscount Glenapp. This smaller second floor room was the childhood bedroom of the present Earl, hence its name.

The room has fitted barley coloured Wilton carpets and a carved Adam style fireplace with real flame gas fire. The bed is a standard UK double bed measuring four feet six inches by six feet three inches. The room has a television, DVD, VCR and CD player and trouser press as well as direct dial telephone.

The bathroom measures 56 square feet and has an Edwardian cast iron suite in blue with a large cast iron bathtub and over bath shower, a pedestal basin with a large marble shelf and a heated towel rail. There are luxurious towels and bathrobes, toiletries by Penhaligon and direct dial telephone.

- 'The Earl of Orkney' is adjacent to the library, and directly below 'The Earl of Inchcape'. These two Master Rooms can communicate, if required, by means of a spiral staircase.
- 'Bryce', 'Hunter' and 'Garleffin' share the first floor of the East Wing.
- 'Knockdolian' and 'Beneraird' share the west ground floor corridor.
- 'Kilantringan', 'Ballantrae' and 'Ardstinchar' share the central ground floor corridor.
- 'Auchencrosh' and 'Altimeg' share the ground floor corridor of the East Wing.
